Class A motorhomes are the largest and can be the most expensive on the market. They are “homes on wheels” and a great choice for full-time travelers. These motorhomes can be built on the Ford F-53 Stripped Chassis.

Class B motorhomes are the smallest “homes on wheels.” Their more compact size makes them easier to maneuver while still offering features of home like a sleeping area, bath area and kitchen. The Ford Transit Passenger Van or Cargo Van can be used to build Class B Motorhomes.

Class C motorhomes are mid-sized and a blend of Classes A and B. They resemble a larger van camper with a cabin above the driver and passenger seats for additional sleeping or storage. Class C motorhomes can be built on either Ford Transit 350 Cutaway or E-Series Cutaway Chassis.
